National Institutes of Health

NEW PHS Human Subject and Clinical Trial Information form

This form will be required for all NIH submissions for due dates on or after January 25, 2018, even those that do not involve human subjects.

The form consolidates information on human subjects that is currently scattered across a number of forms into a single location. It allows NIH to capture descriptive information for each study included in a grant application or contract proposal, which will allow them to clearly identify which funded studies will require registration and timely reporting of results.

NEW Proposal & Award Policies and Procedures Guide (PAPPG) goes into effect for proposals due on or after January 29, 2018

Significant Changes to Proposal Guidelines:

- Use of standard NSF Collaborators & Other Affiliations (COA) form now required for all submissions
- Project Description requires a separate section specifically identified as “Intellectual Merit”
- Up to 5 pages allowed for Budget Justification

Streamlyne Research is Live

The Office of Research and KU IT are pleased to announce that Streamlyne Research is now live and is being used by Pre-Award Staff for all proposals. As discussed in Town Hall meetings for the Financial System Transformation, there will be some changes that will impact the research community.

1. PI Checklist

PI Compliance Checklists will now be completed in Streamlyne. Once your proposal has been assigned by your research center, or kucrpemgmt@lists.ku.edu, you will receive a notification from Streamlyne with instructions for completing the checklist.

Click on the live link to the proposal number and follow the instructions in the email. If you have questions, contact your proposal preparer. His or her name and email address will be included in the email notification.

2. PI Certification and Approval

Principal Investigators will be required to certify and approve all proposals before submission to the sponsor. When certification is required, you will receive a notification from Streamlyne that includes three live links:

- Clicking on the first link will take you directly to your proposal.
- Clicking on the second link will take you to your Action List which shows all proposals requiring your attention.
- You should disregard the third link.

Your preparer's name will appear as the 'Initiator' at the top of the email. Contact this person with any questions.

3. Department Chair, Dean, and Director Approval

Once the PI has certified and approved the proposal for submission, Department Chairs/Center Directors, and Deans will receive notifications from Streamlyne requesting their approval. Although Chair, Dean, and Director approvals are not required before proposal submission to the sponsor, these individuals are encouraged to complete the approval process as soon as they receive notifications.

Notifications will include three live links:

- Clicking on the first link will take you directly into the proposal.
- Clicking on the second link will take you to your Action List which shows all proposals requiring your attention.
- You should disregard the third link.

The proposal preparer's name will appear as the 'Initiator' at the top of the email. Contact this person with any questions.
