Improving Graduate Student Preparedness for the Chemistry Workforce

Opportunities for Supplemental Funding

Examples of experiences targeted by this opportunity include, but are not limited to, limited duration internships or similar experiences in industry, state or federal government laboratories, policy organizations, and non-profit foundations. Consideration would also be given to professional development courses on, for example, innovation and technology commercialization, business and entrepreneurship training, and communicating science to the public. Such courses should not be undertaken in order to directly benefit the student's research project. Activities that include an international component are also encouraged. It is expected that student participation in these experiences will enhance their skills for attaining a competitive position in the job market. Note: Funding requests for conference attendance will not be considered for this supplemental funding opportunity. This opportunity is open to M.S. and Ph.D. graduate students currently supported on NSF CHE individual investigator or small group research grants. Graduate students must have completed at least one academic year as a full time student and be in good academic standing within their Department. These eligibility requirements must be certified by the Chair of the graduate program for the institution at which the application originates.

Supplemental funding requests should be submitted no later than **March 1, 2017**.
