

Standard invention disclosure

Used for potentially patentable inventions (therapeutics, chemical compositions, devices, processes, diagnostics, etc.) or if uncertain which form fits best.



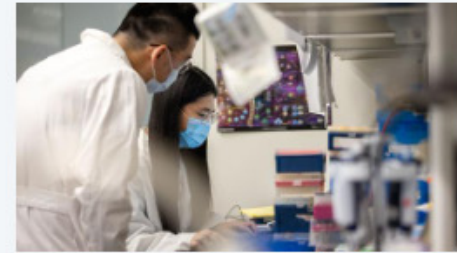
Creative work disclosure

Used for writings, videos, music or other works that may be protectable by copyright, such as surveys, assessments or tools.



Software disclosure

Used for disclosing software, mobile applications, or other computer implemented programs that have been developed.



Research tool disclosure

Used for disclosing research tools and reagents such as antibodies, plasmids, cell lines, or unique animal models.

Disclosing an invention is an early and important step in the technology transfer process - it helps document the intellectual property that you helped create and provides KUCTC with information relevant to the discovery/innovation/invention. This information will help inform KUCTC as we assess patentability, market potential, and other factors that are relevant to commercializing the invention. We strongly encourage you to submit an Invention Disclosure Form prior to any public disclosure (publication, poster, presentation, etc.) that could adversely affect the patentability of an invention. We recommend you complete an Invention Disclosure Form when i) something new and useful has been discovered or conceived; ii) when unusual, unexpected, or surprising research results have been found; or iii) you've developed/created something you believe to have commercial potential or use to others outside academia.

The Software Disclosure Form is divided into five sections; please fill out each part as completely as possible.

Part 1 - Description of the Software – A good description is key to helping KUCTC's team understand your software.

1. Title: The title should be brief but descriptive; if you can avoid using jargon or acronyms, we appreciate it.
2. Software Description: Please describe the software to the best of your abilities. Key points to highlight when applicable include
 - a. What is the general purpose, problem, or challenge solved by the software?
 - b. What is the existing process, product, or way for solving the problem; where do those existing products or processes fall short?
 - c. How does the disclosed software improve upon the current state of the art or overcome existing disadvantages? Are there other advantages of the work you want KUCTC to be aware of?
 - d. What are the key new features of the software (in comparison to prior solutions or software)?
 - e. Any thoughts about how the end user of the work/tool would benefit from the invention are also welcomed.
3. Our innovators are also great resources as they are knowledgeable of their field and often have existing industry relationships. This optional information assists KUCTC in conducting its review of the disclosed invention. No additional research on the part of our innovators is expected, but if you have thoughts or ideas, we will happily accept them, including your ideas on how this newly disclosed invention may differ from similar existing technologies. If you harbor entrepreneurial interests yourself and are considering a startup company to advance the disclosed invention, it can be mentioned here.
